Dear Parents/Carers,

Welcome back to the summer term. We hope you had a good break and enjoyed the bank holiday weekend. This half term our main learning is based around dinosaurs. Please may we remind you to regularly access your child's google classroom account. On there you can find online learning opportunities, additional materials that may support learning at home, as well as news and exciting things to share at home. Please contact your child's class teacher if you are having problems logging on. If you stumble across any technical issues while using the classroom, we would initially recommend googling your difficulty as it is created by the same company and has many useful help pages.

With the changing weather, we ask that all children have their wellie boots in school for their environmental session and they are brought into school on the day each week which is as follows (these have changed so please take note):

Please continue to ensure both classes wear PE kits into school each Friday. Please may we remind you that children should be wearing navy jogging bottoms or shorts, with the uniform yellow airtex top, or their Battle of the Bubble t-shirt if they received one at Busy Bees. If a jumper is necessary it should also be a navy jumper or hoodie. We would also like to remind you to ensure **all** children have a complete spare uniform including underwear and socks on their peg for accidents and falls. Please also ensure this change of clothes are clearly named. The pool is currently having a complete refurbishment and we are hoping the work will be completed in a few weeks' time. We will Ping when completed to share more information with you about our swimming sessions.

As the weather warms up, you may wish to dress your children in summer uniform. If you have any queries about dress code for the summer uniform, please do not hesitate to contact the office. We would also like to encourage all children to have spare socks/school uniform in their PE bags in case of accidents or falls in the playground. We would also like to remind you to ensure all items are named so they can be returned to the right owners.

A few other (gentle) little reminders from us;

-Please may children be reminded to leave **all** toys and soft toys at home. It is a constant worry for us that toys will get damaged or lost.

-Please may children bring in a named **fresh** piece of fruit into school for morning break. We would like children not to have forks/spoons as they move around while eating their fruit, and we discourage the fruit snack bars and winders.

- The children receive drinks in the morning, either, milk or water. If you wish to change your child's choice of drink for morning break time please do just let us know at the door or in a quick email.
