

Jewellery and Earrings in PE Guidance

As part of the risk assessments associated with Covid-19, we took the opportunity to review many of our school policies associated with children's health, safety and well-being. One of these is the wearing of jewellery during school PE lessons.

Wearing jewellery or earrings for physical activities poses a serious risk of injury to both the wearer and other children and therefore as the children are having PE on specified days, jewellery and earrings must be removed before school on the designated days. Taping of piercings will also not be allowed as this provides inadequate protection to both the wearer and other children.

Please ensure that you consider this guidance when choosing an appropriate time for piercings.
