Over the summer a temporary classroom unit was installed for our new Year 5 classes. You may have seen the huge crane which lifted the six pieces in on a sunny day in August. They were then fitted together and ready to be filled with equipment and resources. The temporary unit has two large classrooms, a reading area and toilets. The school staff had a busy summer getting everything ready but the new Year 5s have settled into their new space very quickly.

Work has begun to build our new classroom block which will have 5 classrooms. Four classrooms for Year 5 and 6 and one for other Key Stage 2 learning activities, such as, drama, science and food technology. There are also some adaptations being made to the existing building. This is to create a dedicated Reception area at the front of the school for our youngest children.

We will continue to update our families and the community as the work continues over the coming months.

Despite all the changes over the summer and recent weeks, all the children have settled in well to the start of the school year including our new starters at Swallowfield Primary.
