## Year 5 and 6 Information

#### **Equipment**

As promised at the Year 5/6 meeting earlier this month, I have created an equipment list with suggestions of the types of equipment required. I have included photographs and weblinks as examples, but these are for guidance only and not intended as specific requirements. The list is attached to this letter.

### Maths Home Learning

We have identified a resource that is being published by White Rose Maths that can be used to support your child at home and we would also like to use for Maths Homework and Maths Homework Club. We will be ordering these directly into school and will advise you as soon as we receive them. You will be able to purchase these directly from school in the Autumn Term at a cost of approximately £5.

#### Drop-off and Pick Up

This will be from the new park gate. The gates will be opened at 8.45am and closed at 8.55am. School will finish at 3.15pm and children will be released from the park gate. If you are happy for your child to walk to or from school, please email your child's class teacher to advise them of your consent. We do understand that for peace of mind your child may want to bring a phone to school – this is allowed but phones must be switched off and given to the class teacher each morning for safekeeping.

If for some reason the park gate is not ready in September, we will advise you of alternative arrangements prior to the start of school.
