YEAR 5 START/FINISH TIMES

Year 5 School Hours: 8.45am - 3.15pm.

School will finish at 3.15pm and children will be released from their classrooms.

If you are happy for your child to walk to or from school, please email your child's class teacher to advise them of your consent.

We do understand that for peace of mind your child may want to bring a phone to School – this is allowed but phones must be switched off and given to the class teacher each morning for safekeeping.

PLEASE NOTE: that the new park gate is not ready yet so we would like all Y5s to enter the school through the main school gate into the playground.

This year Mrs Woodman and Ms Sharpe are the Year 5 teachers, and we are supported by Mrs Scouller and Mrs Miller. We also welcome Mrs Mutchell and Mrs Crabbe who are new Cover Supervisors. We are excited to be working together to support and challenge your children as they continue their KS2 journey at Swallowfield.

Our History topic this half term is the Vikings and we will be learning about Earth and Space in Science. We are busy planning lots of exciting activities for the children. Details of all our planned learning for this term are attached along with this letter. You will also find copies of our medium-term plans, knowledge organisers for specific subjects and example timetables on the school website and in Google Classrooms.

PE and Swimming
