Dear Parents and Carers,

We hope that you all had a restful, healthy and enjoyable Easter break.

This term our Geography, Art and DT learning will be delivered through the topic 'Africa'. We will be learning all about Physical and Human landmarks found in Africa, and comparing our lives with those of the Masai people. The homework task document will also be available on the Year group page of the school website. Any completed homework should be submitted via Google Classroom. Photographs or short video clips are an excellent way to record projects or practical pieces of work. We understand that it is sometimes difficult to find time for the children to complete their Learning Tasks, but we do encourage them to complete at least one piece per week.

Home School Library Our Home School library day will continue to be on a Tuesday. Please ensure your child's book is returned on that day so that they may choose a replacement. We will continue to check the children's Reading Logs weekly.

Sun Safety We are hoping to be blessed with a lot of sunshine over the coming term! Please apply all day sunscreen before school rather than sending bottles into school. If your child is particularly sensitive to the sun then we would request that you send a named bottle into school that can be kept in the classroom and used when necessary. We recommend that children come to school with a named sun hat as we move further into the Summer term.
