Dear Parents/Carers,

Welcome back and we wish you a Happy New Year! We hope that you had a good Christmas break and would like to express our thanks for the kind words, cards and gifts we received.

This term in Year 2, we will continue to build on key skills in Maths and English, helping the children grow in confidence with number, problem-solving, reading and writing. In Science, we will be exploring the uses of everyday materials and how they are suited to different purposes. Our Art lessons will focus on landscapes and famous artists, encouraging creativity and observation skills. In Design and Technology, children will learn about a balanced diet and the importance of healthy food choices. Geography will centre on the question "*Why is our world wonderful?*" as children discover the features that make our planet special, while in History we will investigate *How did we learn to fly?*, exploring the exciting history of flight.. Homework

Homework will be uploaded to Google Classroom this week. The children will continue to receive **weekly spellings** and will be tested on the following Friday. **Home Learning Tasks** will also be uploaded. Any completed homework should be submitted via Google Classroom. Photographs or short video clips are an excellent way to record projects or practical pieces of work. It will not be necessary to submit spelling practice. We understand that it is sometimes difficult to find time for the children to complete their home learning tasks, but we do encourage them to complete one piece most weeks. We will also be introducing the children to **times tables** and it would be great if these could be practiced at home each week. Please see the separate letter with more information.
